



INSTALLATION OF HIPS & VALLEYS

Hips/Valleys are used to cover corners and gutters.

Use only one hip/valley on every other row or, if you make your own hips with Palmex leaves, fix one hip on every row. This option is not recommended for valleys.

Installation of hips/valleys is the same whether you use Bora Bora/Aloha or Domingo/Rio.



Fix the hips/valleys gradually with the leaves.



For Bora Bora/Aloha, cut the edge of the leaf at the junction from the top rail along the rafter and up to the top of the row below.



From that point, cut the leaf with a slight angle to cover the leaf from the opposite side of the row below.



For the other side of the same junction, cut with an angle starting from the top to the end of the leaf.



Lay a hip/valley over the leaves at the center of the rafter.



Screw the hip/valley to the rafter with a minimum of two screws.

Repeat steps 1 to 6 for every row up to the top of the roof.
